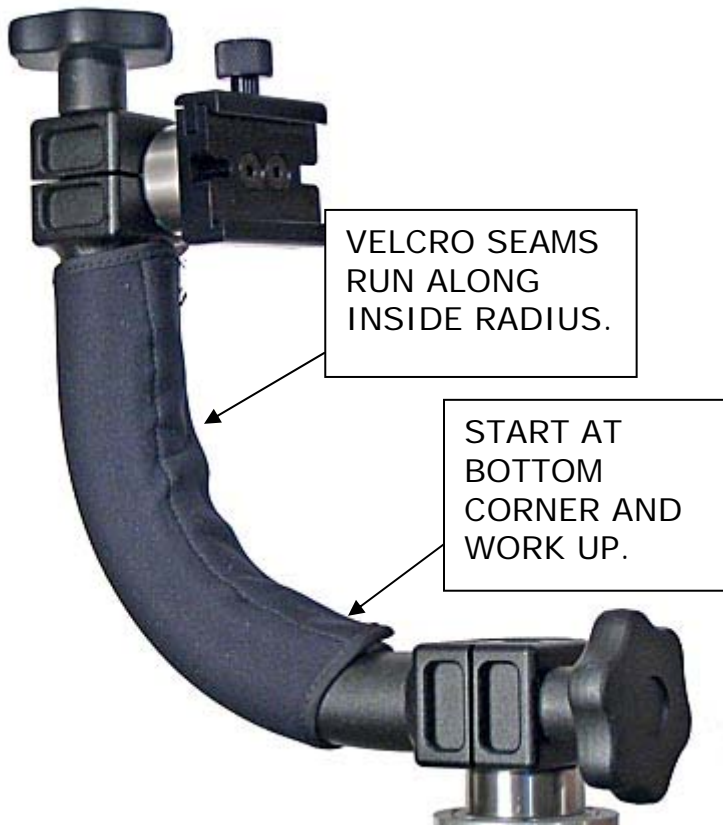

NEOPRENE COVER FOR BLACK WIDOW GIMBAL TRIPOD HEAD

Usage:

The Neoprene Cover for the BWG is a simple device that protects the BWG from paint chips, while cushioning your grip in cold weather. It offers a great layer of protection to your fingers by insulating them from the cold bare metal. Trust us -- we're from Canada, we know cold-weather shooting!

Installation:

1. Firstly, we apologize because this is a tricky thing to get on right the first time! Take your time and be patient.
2. The only way the cover fits is with the Velcro seam along the inside edge of the radius, as shown in Fig A. The neoprene will only stretch in this direction.
3. The rubber surface goes against the BWG.
4. With one hand, hold the 'hook-and-loop' part of the Velcro against the inside radius of the BWG.
5. Slowly overlap the Neoprene Cover with the fuzzy Velcro working your way up from the bottom end.
6. Keep sticking and resticking the Velcro until you've worked it closed and tightened it all along the seam.

Tip! The rubber is very sticky to prevent the cover from slipping on the BWG. If you are finding it extra tough to install the cover there is no harm in spraying the rubber with water to lubricate it while you fit it to the BWG.
